Iran's attack on Israel was a hoax by Biden and Sullivan. Of course, with the cooperation of Israel and Iran and Bortnikov.

1. The attack was incomprehensible to common sense.

I had a feeling that Sullivan had arranged this at the first report that Iran had attacked Israel.

Some of the following were directed to be communicated to Sullivan through the US Ambassador to Japan at that time.

The answer appears in the ISW report dated April 14th.

(1) Do Iran's Shahed drones arrive from Iranian territory?

Shahed once entered the wrong latitude and longitude en route in Ukraine, missed his target, and ran out of fuel and crashed. The cruising range at that time was estimated to be 500-800km.

(2) What flight path did it follow?

ISW seems to have accepted that it would fly through Iraq, Syria, and Jordan, but it is natural to avoid Jordanian airspace when attacking, so it is unnatural that they accepted that they flew there.

Also, flying to Jordan via Syria would be a detour, which would be unnatural when considering an attack.

(3) ISW has written that it has identified the types of ballistic missiles and drones used by US allies, but from an attacker's perspective, such a route would not be chosen

Given the range announced by Iran, the route would be to fly the drones low over the sea and land on land as soon as possible in Israel. At the very least, a military officer would never think of launching a drone along such a route that ISW had accepted.

Flying to a high altitude, just right for Israel's Iron Dome interceptor, is not done when attacking Ukraine.

Iran, which is more adept at handling drones than Russia, would never do something stupid like fly it to a height where it is easy to shoot it down.

(4) Why did Iran announce the attack before any damage was done?

As was the case with Israel, it would be completely unthinkable for them to make an announcement before a bullet hits the ground.

It is not used for terrorism, but only when a front is declared to "We start a war against your country."

Moreover, at that time, the side that declar the start of the war would not say anything about attacking.

(5) Even though this could be called a declaration of war against Israel, why did the Iranian people scream with joy even before the bullet hit?

Why did Iran so quickly announce that it would "no longer attack" when it could not have caused any damage and was fearing retaliation from Israel?

(6) They should have known that most of the missiles and drones would be dropped at Iron Dome. If so, a few ballistic missiles would be enough. Why did Iran make the waste of firing so many slow Shaheds?

It would make sense if there was a proposal from Israel for the marketing of Iron Dome for the Hamas ceasefire. It is also understandable if you consider that the US did this in order to shock Ukraine when the US budget for supporting Ukraine was not approved.

(7) There was a comment saying that the UK had flown fighter jets. However, both ballistic missiles and drones are shot down using interceptor missiles, rather than using air-to-air missiles from fighter jets.

It is extremely unnatural why they sent out fighter jets.

Even if fighter jets are trained to take off against fastfalling ballistic missiles that take time to take off, they will likely not be able to shoot them down unless Iran makes an announcement shortly after launch.

Are fighter pilots trained to intercept extremely slow and small drones with expensive air-to-air missiles?

(8) ISW writes that Russia conducted extensive airstrikes against Ukraine to prevent Iranian missiles from being able to influence Ukraine's air defenses.

Based on the flight course of the airstrike, it has no connection to Ukraine and has no connection whatsoever.

Why did ISW go out of its way to bring this up as a related matter?

(9) ISW wrote:

ISW240414 > Ukraine's large size compared to Israel makes it more difficult for Ukraine to emulate the density of air defense coverage that Israel enjoys, especially amid continued delays in US security assistance.

Why did the ISW make these comments when trying to pass a budget to support Israel? They are saying that there is no urgency for a budget to support Israel.

This means that the budget for aid to Israel is sufficient, and it is hard to imagine that Biden and Sullivan know that the bill will not be passed.

Furthermore, ISW has continued to have close discussions with Sullivan.

I believe that ISW is commenting on behalf of the Biden administration. Therefor so far I have been able to predict and predict the movements of Biden and Sullivan.

If the US continues as it is, humanity around the world will be in a very dire state a century from now. The US should regain a form of government with some intelligence.

The US has only a low level of freedom and democracy.
